Thursday, 3-31-16)

The very first Resource Net was held this evening. The net's full name is currently "The Southern Colorado Amateur Radio Resource Net." The net sprang from events within R5D2; but PARC and PWARC have added their additional support and abilities. This inaugural net lasted 36 minutes. There were seven stations present. No newly-licensed ham checked in. However, a couple fairly new to the area were there. All stations introduced themselves. They also talked of their varied interests in hamming and public service.
