2010 ... First Officers 5010 ... First Officers

PWARC was founded upon Bill Ewing's WAOKAQ (now a SK) vision of a club open to anyone who had an interest in amateur radio communications in August 2009.

Bill sent a postcard to amateur radio operations in the 81007 zip code, and 17 individuals rallied. Thus, PWARC was on its way!

By word-of-mouth, others quickly followed ... and by year-end 2009, there were 19 members. By year-end 2010, the club had 24 members.

The Colorado Secretary of State approved its Articles of Incorporation on December 22, 2009. ARRL affiliation was granted in June 2010 and on August 30, 2011, the IRS granted PWARC a 501(c)(3) tax-exempt status.
