

For clear communications under all conditions, use a phonetic alphabet for spelling out critical information. Instead of "A B C", use "Alpha Bravo Charlie." Letters such as D, T and V can sound alike during noisy conditions, whereas Delta, Tango and Victor are more distinct.

The standard phonetic alphabet for amateur radio comes from the *International* 

Telecommunication Union (ITU).

This aphabet is also referred to as the NATO or International Aviation alphabet although the spelling of the words may change slightly.

This is the phonetic alphabet that should be committed to memory for ham radio use.

### The Mother Road




The 21st Annual Route 66 On The Air Special Event September 12-20, 2020 ... 0001 Z on September 12 to 2359 Z on September 20

For 2019, the 20th Anniversary of Route 66 On the Air, the Northern Arizona DX Association offered three QSL cards.

W6S was the the official 2019 QSL. When lined up with the W6G and W6T QSLs, the front of the QSL forms a reproduction of the first event certificate from 2000. W6S operated portable from the iconic town of "Don't Forget" Winona on Old Route 66, a few miles east of Flagstaff, Arizona.











(1) Birthplace

Most concur it is Chicago; but could be both depending on how one reads highway numbers, as there is some debate as whether the true Route 66 starts in Springfield, MO

- (2) Relive the Ride is another name used to call Route 66.
- (3) Mid-point of Route 66 is Adrian, TX ... 1,139 miles to Chicago and 1,139 miles to Los Angeles
- (4) Interstate Highways that parallel Route 66 are: I-40, I-55 and I-44
- (5) Route 66 traverses through five ARRL districts ...starting with District 9 and meandering through 0, 5, 7 and ending in 6.
- (6) Route 66 splits from I-40 in District Zero.
- (7) There are 22 ITU phonetics.
- (8) There are two US Route 66 road signs. The other signs are either state or historic signs.
- (9) Will Rogers Highway and Main Street of America
- (10) **Bonus**: US Route 60 and US Route 62
